Fetlock LF: LM, DL-PaMO, DM-PaLO: Small enlarged synovial channel at the proximal medial sesamoid bone.

Fetlock RF: LM, DPa: No significant radiographic remarks

Fetlock LH: LM, DL-PIMO, DM-PILO: Triangular fragment at the proximal border of the proximal medial sesamoid bone

Fetlock RH: LM, DL-PIMO, DM-PILO: No significant radiographic remarks

Hock L: LM, DL-PIMO, DM-PILO, DPI: Small regular outlined enthesiophyt at the dorsoproximal aspect of the third metatarsus III. Regular outlined joint space.

Hock R: LM, DL-PIMO, DM-PILO, DPI: Small regular outlined enthesiophyt at the dorsoproximal aspect of the third metatarsus III. Regular outlined joint space.

Stifle L: LM: No significant radiographic remarks

Stifle R: LM: No significant radiographic remarks
